Title: Lord, Teach us to Pray

**Text**: Luke 11:1–4 (Matthew 6:9-13)

#### Introduction

Luke 11:1

Prayer is not primarily about getting what we want. Prayer is about being transformed by relationship with God, becoming who God wants us to be. Ultimately, prayer is not about a search for things, but it is for communion with God.

How do we know God through prayer?

1. He is the Head "Our Father, who is in heaven"

Ephesians 1:4,5

He is our Father

Prayer is communal - Matthew 18:19-20

**2.** He is to be Worshipped "`may your name be kept holy."

We must be careful to not become so casual in our worship of God, so common in our approach to God that we forget who we are and who He is.

He is a holy God - Isaiah 6:1-4

3. He is to be Obeyed "May your Kingdom come soon."

Psalm 113

- 4. **He is our Provider** Give us each day the food we need,
- 5. **He Is Our Redeemer** "and forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who sin against us"

Matthew 5:23-24

6. He also is our Protector And don't let us yield to temptation."
