- 6) What is the biggest wall, or fear that you could use courage in today? What is one practical action step you will take to live a more courageous life?

Army's Definition of Courage – <u>Facing</u> fear, danger, or adversity.
Webster's Definition of Courage - Mental or moral strength to venture, persevere, and withstand danger, fear or difficulty.
A Biblical Definition of Courage - Not the <u>absence</u> of fear, but putting our faith and <u>confidence</u> in God to overcome our fears through his grace, power, and presence.
