What Do we Learn about Mary?

- 1. She Felt Afraid.**
- 2. She was imperfect.**
- 3. She Carried a Cross.**

What Do we learn From God?

- 1. My Grace is for you.**

- 2. My Presence is with you.**

- 3. My Power and Provision are for you.**

Mary's Response:

I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered. "May it be to me as you have said." Then the angel left her.
(v. 38)
