

Introduction

Question: What if you could change the world with only minimal change to your routine? -

How can you Bless Your Neighbor this week?

B – Begin with Prayer

- 'God, how do you want me to bless the people in the places you've sent me to?'
- Matthew 9:36-38
- 1. Make sharing the good news of the Kingdom of God the highest priority of your life.
- 2. Let God break your heart with what breaks His.
- 3. Passionately pray for God to intervene into the lives of people.

L – Listen

- Don't talk, but listen to people, their struggles, their pains, in the places God sent you.
- How can we Bless our neighbors through listening?
 - Set aside your prejudices and biases.
 - John 4:9
 - Listen more than you talk
 - James 1:19; Proverbs 18:2
 - Listen with patience.
 - Listen with humility
 - Philippians 2:3-4
 - Ask great questions
 - Matthew 16:13-15
