Building on A Firm Foundation Joseph: A Story of Overcoming Faith!

<u>Big Idea</u>: In tests, God is building a <u>testimony!</u> In our challenges God is building our <u>character</u> and a deep mature <u>faith</u>.

How to survive and thrive in discouraging circumstances?

2 ways People handle Discouragement:

- 1) It makes them Bitter
- 2) It makes them Better
- 1. Don't Give Up on God!
- 2. Don't Give In to Temptation.

"Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in the faith" (1 Peter 5:8-9).

- 3. Don't miss out on God's purposes in our Problems.
 - 2 Principles Joseph Learned in his pain:
 - 1) Joseph found meaning even in these very disappointing circumstances.
 - 2) In his disappointing circumstances God was preparing Joseph for something greater.
