
V1-11: benefits of justification


Romans 6:12-13


12 Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its lusts, 13 and do not go on presenting your members to sin as instruments of unrighteousness,

but present yourselves to God as those alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

- DO not let sin reign (v12)
- DO not present yourself to sin (v13)
- DO present yourself to God (v13)






Romans 6:14

Romans 6:15-16


15 What then? Shall we sin because we are not under law but under grace? May it never be!

16 Do you not know that when you go on presenting yourselves to someone as slaves for obedience, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin leading to death, or of obedience leading to righteousness?

Romans 6:17-19

17 But thanks be to God that though you were slaves of sin, you obeyed from the heart that pattern of teaching to which you were given over, 18 and having been freed from sin, you became slaves of righteousness. 19 I am speaking in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you presented your members as slaves to impurity and to lawlessness, leading to further lawlessness, so now present your members as slaves to righteousness, leading to sanctification.



Romans 6:20-22



For the end of those things is death. 22 But now having been freed from sin and enslaved to God, you have your benefit, leading to sanctification, and the end, eternal life.


