**SEATED**

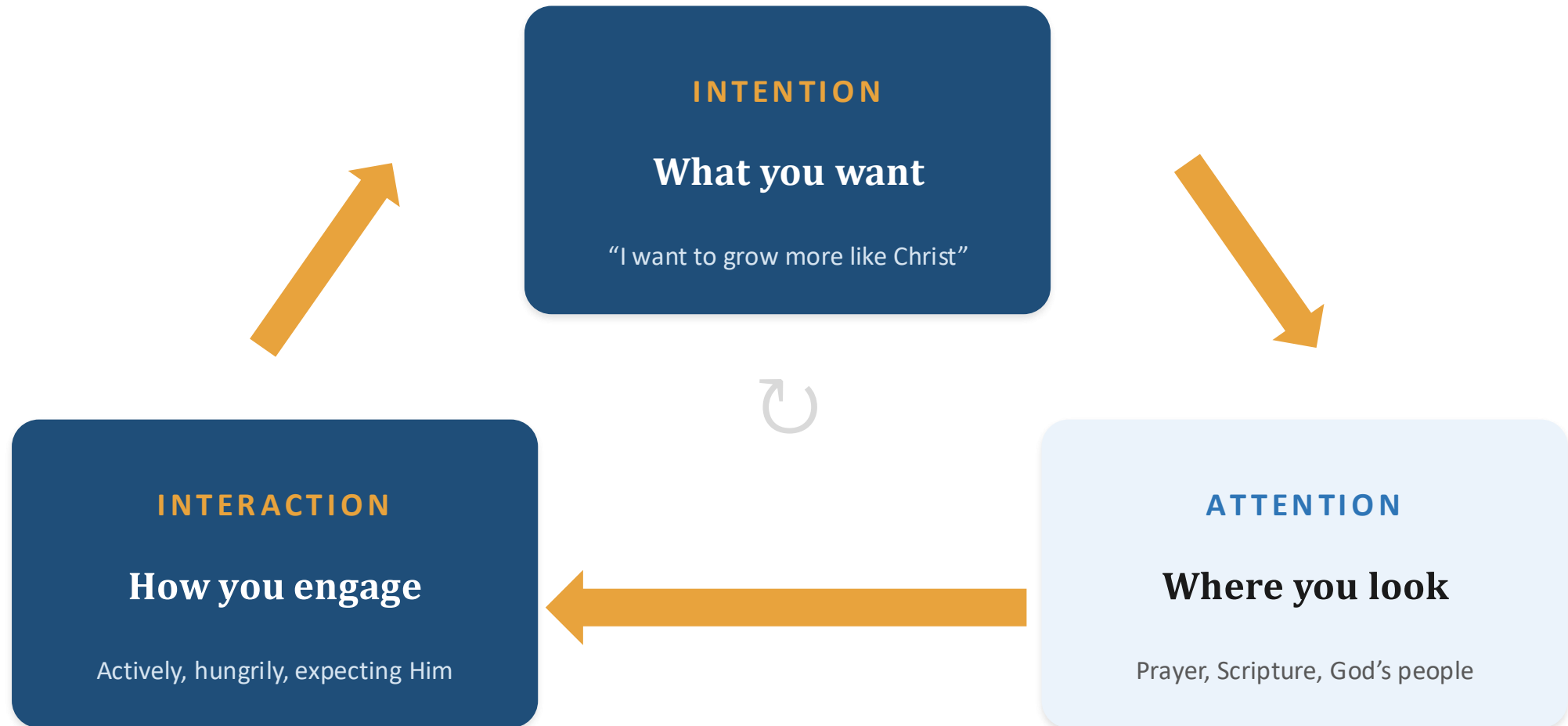
*in the heavenly places*

# It all loops together

*Your intention sets your attention — your attention shapes your interaction — and that loops back to deepen the intention.*

## YOUR ATTENTION

*“Why would I need to know this?”*

Optional. Curious at best.  
Easy to tune out.



## YOUR INTENTION

*“I need to know this before I walk out the door.”*

Necessary. Urgent.  
Impossible to ignore.

*Paul is writing to people who have to live this. So are we.*

**Box**

Any name or title for God — Father, Son, Spirit, Lord, Christ



**Circle**

Important nouns — people, places, key words worth stopping on



**Underline**

Action words and grace words — things being done or given



**Bracket**

A connected idea — words that belong together as one concept



**Arrow**

Connects one thing to another — in the text, or to your notes page

*Not sure whether to circle or underline? Just pick one and draw an arrow to explain your thinking. The arrow saves everything.*

**1** And you were dead in your trespasses and sins,

## Ephesians 2:3-4

**3** Among them we too all formerly [lived in the lusts of our flesh], doing the [desires of the flesh and of the mind], and were by nature [children of wrath], even as the rest.

**4** But God, being [rich in mercy], because of His great love with [which He loved us],

## Ephesians 2:5-6

5 even when we were dead in our transgressions,  
[made us alive together with Christ] [by grace you  
have been saved]

6 and [raised us up with Him] and seated us [with  
Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus]

## Ephesians 2:7-8

**7** so that in the [ages to come] **He** might show [the surpassing riches] of [His grace in kindness] toward **us** in Christ Jesus.

**8** [For by grace] **you** have been [saved through faith]; and that [not of yourselves] [it is the **gift** of **God**];

## Ephesians 2:9-10

9 not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.
