Exodus 28:1 “Then bring near to you Aaron your brother, and his sons with him, from among the people of Israel, to serve me as priests – Aaron and Aaron’s sons, Nadab and Abihu, Eleazar and Ithamar.

2 And you shall make holy garments for Aaron your brother, for glory and for beauty...

Exodus 29:28 It shall be for Aaron and his sons as a perpetual due from the people of Israel, for it is a contribution. It shall be a contribution from the people of Israel from their peace offerings, their contribution to the Lord. **29** "The holy garments of Aaron shall be for his sons after him; they shall be anointed in them and ordained in them.

Exodus 29:30 The son who succeeds him as priest, who comes into the tent of meeting to minister in the Holy Place, shall wear them seven days. **31** "You shall take the ram of ordination and boil its flesh in a holy place. **32** And Aaron and his sons shall eat the flesh of the ram and the bread that is in the basket in the entrance of the tent of meeting.

Exodus 29:33 They shall eat those things with which atonement was made at their ordination and consecration, but an outsider shall not eat of them, because they are holy. **34** And if any of the flesh for the ordination or of the bread remain until the morning, then you shall burn the remainder with fire. It shall not be eaten, because it is holy.

Exodus 29:35 "Thus you shall do to Aaron and to his sons, according to all that I have commanded you. Through seven days shall you ordain them, **36** and every day you shall offer a bull as a sin offering for atonement. Also you shall purify the altar, when you make atonement for it, and shall anoint it to consecrate it. **37** Seven days you shall make atonement for the

Exodus 29:37 ...altar and consecrate it, and the altar shall be most holy. Whatever touches the altar shall become holy.

38 "Now this is what you shall offer on the altar: two lambs a year old day by day regularly. **39** One lamb you shall offer in the morning, and the other lamb you shall offer at twilight. **40** And with the first lamb a tenth seah of fine flour mingled with a

Exodus 29:40 ...fourth of a hin of beaten oil, and a fourth of a hin of wine for a drink offering. **41** The other lamb you shall offer at twilight, and shall offer with it a grain offering and its drink offering, as in the morning, for a pleasing aroma, a food offering to the Lord. **42** It shall be a regular burnt offering throughout your generations at the entrance of the tent of meeting

Exodus 29:42 ...before the Lord, where I will meet with you, to speak to you there.

43 There I will meet with the people of Israel, and it shall be sanctified by my glory. **44** I will consecrate the tent of meeting and the altar. Aaron also and his sons I will consecrate to serve me as priests. **45** I will dwell among the people of Israel and will be their God.

Exodus 29:46 And they shall know that I am the Lord their God, who brought them out of the land of Egypt that I might dwell among them. I am the Lord their God.

Exodus 28:1 “Then bring near to you Aaron your brother, and his sons with him, from among the people of Israel, to **serve me as priests** – Aaron and Aaron’s sons, Nadab and Abihu, Eleazar and Ithamar.

1. Why Do We Need Priests?

Exodus 28:2 And you shall make holy garments for Aaron your brother, for glory and for beauty. 3 You shall speak to all the skillful, whom I have filled with a spirit of skill, that they make Aaron's garments to **consecrate** him for my priesthood.

1. Why Do We Need Priests?

Romans 3:23 ...For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

1. Why Do We Need Priests?

Exodus 28:29 So Aaron shall bear the names of the sons of Israel in the breastpiece of judgment on his heart, when he goes into the Holy Place, to bring them to regular remembrance before the Lord.

30 ...Thus Aaron shall bear the judgment of the people of Israel on his heart before the Lord regularly.

1. Why Do We Need Priests?

Exodus 29:42 It shall be a regular burnt offering throughout your generations at the entrance of the tent of meeting before the Lord, where I will meet with you, to speak to you there. **43 There I will meet with the people of Israel**, and it shall be sanctified by my glory.

1. Why Do We Need Priests?

Exodus 29:44 I will consecrate the tent of meeting and the altar. Aaron also and his sons I will consecrate to serve me as priests. 45 I will dwell among the people of Israel and will be their God.

1. Why Do We Need Priests?

Exodus 29:46 **And they shall know that I am the Lord their God**, who brought them out of the land of Egypt that I might dwell among them. I am the Lord their God.

1. Why Do We Need Priests?

Exodus 29:1 “Now this is what you shall do to them to consecrate them, that they may serve me as priests. Take one bull of the herd and two rams without blemish, 2 and unleavened bread, unleavened cakes mixed with oil, and unleavened wafers smeared with oil. You shall make them of fine wheat flour.

2. What's the Problem with Priests?

Exodus 29:3 You shall put them in one basket and bring them in the basket, and bring the bull and the two rams. 4 You shall bring Aaron and his sons to the entrance of the tent of meeting and wash them with water.

Exodus 29:38 “Now this is what you shall offer on the altar: two lambs a year old **day by day regularly**. **39** One lamb you shall offer in the morning, and the other lamb you shall offer at twilight.

2. What's the Problem with Priests?

Exodus 30:18 “You shall also make a basin of bronze, with its stand of bronze, for washing. You shall put it between the tent of meeting and the altar, and you shall put water in it, 19 with which Aaron and his sons shall wash their hands and their feet.

Exodus 30:20 When they go into the tent of meeting, or when they come near the altar to minister, to burn a food offering to the Lord, they shall wash with water, so that they may not die.

2. What's the Problem with Priests?

Exodus 19:4 'You yourselves have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself.'

3. How Can We Be Priests?

Exodus 19:5 Now therefore, if you will indeed obey my voice and keep my covenant, **you shall be my treasured possession** among all peoples, for all the earth is mine; 6 and you shall be to me a **kingdom of priests** and a holy nation.'

3. How Can We Be Priests?

1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen race, a royal **priesthood**, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. 10 Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but **now you have received mercy**.

3. How Can We Be Priests?

Hebrews 10:1 For since the law has but a shadow of the good things to come instead of the true form of these realities, it can never, by the same sacrifices that are continually offered every year, make perfect those who draw near.
2 Otherwise, would they not have ceased to be offered, since the worshipers, having once been cleansed, would no longer have any

Hebrews 10:2 consciousness of sins? **3** But in these sacrifices there is a reminder of sins every year. **4** For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.

5 Consequently, when Christ came into the world, he said, "Sacrifices and offerings you have not desired, but a body have you prepared for me;

Hebrews 10:10 And by that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. **11** And every priest stands daily at his service, offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins.

3. How Can We Be Priests?

Hebrews 10:12 But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God, **13** waiting from that time until his enemies should be made a footstool for his feet. **14** For by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified.
