John is addressing:

- 1. "Children" those who are young in their faith
- 2. "Young men" those who are in the middle of their journey with Jesus
- 3. "Fathers" those who have been walking with Jesus for a long time

1. John's Encouragement - "Children"

- 1 John 2:13 I am writing to you, young men, because you have overcome the evil one.
- 1 John 2:14 I write to you, young men because you are strong, and the word of God abides in you, and you have overcome the evil one.
 - 1. John's Encouragement "Young men"

1 John 4:4 Greater is he (Christ) that is in you, than he (Satan) who is in the world.

- 1 John 2:13 I am writing to you, fathers, because you know him who is from the beginning.
- 1 John 2:14 I write to you, fathers, because you know him who is from the beginning.

John's encouragement to:

New Christians → you are forgiven in Christ.

Young Christians → you HAVE overcome through Christ.

Older Christians → you know and are known by Christ

1. John's Encouragement

1 John 2:15 Do not love the world or the things of the world...

1 John 2:16 For all that is in the world—the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride of life

1 John 2:15 ... If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

1 John 2:16 For all that is in the world—the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride of life—is not from the Father but is from the world.

1 John 2:17 And the world is passing away along with its desires, but whoever does the will of God abides forever.

John 17:15 I do not ask that you take them out of the world, but that you keep them from the evil one. 16 They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. 17 Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth. 18 As you sent me into the world, so I have sent them into the world.

3. How to keep the command

1 John 2:14 I write to you, young men because you are strong, and the word of God abides in you, and you have overcome the evil one.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

Gospel realities that filter out the world:

- 1. You are forgiven in Christ.
- 2. You HAVE overcome through Christ.
- 3. You know and are known by Christ

THE WORTH OF JESUS filters out the world!
