A quick word on Slavery in the Roman World

Command #2 (to Bondservants/Employees)

"Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men,"

Command #3 (to Masters/Bosses)

"Masters, treat your bondservants justly and fairly."

in pain you shall eat of it all the days of your life;


18 thorns and thistles it shall bring forth for you;


and you shall eat the plants of the field.

Colossians 1:12 giving thanks to **the Father**, who has **qualified** you to share in the **inheritance** of the saints in light.

Colossians 1:13 He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, 14 in whom we have **redemption**, **the forgiveness of sins**.

God's Work

Philippians 2:8-10

8 And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death even death on a cross!

9 Therefore God exalted him to the highest place

and gave him the name that is above every name,

10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow,

in heaven and on earth and under the earth,



3:25 For the wrongdoer will be paid back for the wrong he has done, and there is no partiality.
