What is this peace? Peace with God

Romans 5:1

“We have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ”

The Christmas SONG (Luke 2:14)

How does Jesus give this peace? **By His Death**

Romans 8:8,10

“But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us...while we were God’s enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son”

Luke 3:22

“You are my beloved Son; with you I am well
pleased.”

Luke 15:7

*“I tell you that in the same way there will be more
rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents.”*

Psalm 147:11

*“The Lord takes pleasure in those that hope in His
mercy,”*

The Christmas SONG (Luke 2:14)

Who is God pleased with?

His SON and ALL those who RECEIVE Him as Savior and Lord

Zephaniah 3:17

*The LORD your God...will **rejoice over you** with gladness; he will quiet you by his love;*

*he will **exult over you** with loud singing.*

The Christmas SONG (Luke 2:14)

14 “**Glory** to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom he is pleased!”

The gift of God’s **peace** and gift of His **pleasure** leads to the gift of **Glorifying** God!

Luke 2:15-20

[15] When the angels went away from them into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, “Let us go over to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has made known to us.” [16] And they went with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby lying in a manger.

Luke 2:15-20

[17] And when they saw it, **they made known** the saying that had been told them concerning this child...

[20] And the shepherds returned, **glorifying and praising God** for all they had heard and seen, as it had been told them.
