- 3. Who do you need to say "I am sorry" to and then ask for forgiveness? I Cor. 10:30-32, Matt. 5:23-26, Gen. 20:17, Job 42:7-8. Matt. 5:46-48
- Who are you still waiting for a confession of sorrow from? Heb. 12:24, Eph 4:32, Col. 3:13, Matt. 18:35, James 2:13, I Cor. 13: 5-7, I Pet. 4:8, Luke 6:36-38
- 5. Have you asked Jesus into your life to be your Lord and received God's forgiveness for your sins in the process? If you would like to do so, pray this simple prayer to Him and then tell someone what you did. Pray this to yourself or privately out loud.

"Dear Jesus, I have done things in my life that are not pleasing to you. I have sinned. I am sorry for these things. I acknowledge that as God you died on a cross for me, bearing my sins. I am heartily sorry but grateful that in this acknowledgement of my request to be my Lord, you are also now my Savior. Help me live for you." Amen
