Exodus 7:1 And **the Lord said** to Moses,
"See, I have made you like God to Pharaoh,
and your brother Aaron shall be your prophet.
2 You shall speak all that I command you,
and your brother Aaron shall tell Pharaoh to
let the people of Israel go out of his land. **3**
But I will **harden Pharaoh's heart**, and
though I multiply my signs and wonders in
the land of Egypt,

Exodus 7:4 Pharaoh will not listen to you. Then I will lay my **hand** on Egypt and bring my hosts, my people the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great acts of judgment. **5** The Egyptians **shall know that I am the Lord**, when I stretch out my hand against Egypt and bring out the people of Israel from among them."

Numbers 33:4 Moses says about the plagues “On their gods the Lord also executed judgements”

The Hand of Moses

Exodus 8:5 And the LORD said to Moses, “Say to Aaron, ‘Stretch out your hand with your staff over the rivers, over the canals and over the pools, and make frogs come up on the land of Egypt!’”

The Hand of Moses

Exodus 8:10 Be it as you say, **so that you may know that there is no one like the Lord our God.**

The Hand of Moses

Exodus 10:21 Then the LORD said to Moses, “Stretch out your hand toward heaven, that there may be darkness over the land of Egypt, a darkness to be felt.”

The Hand of Moses

Exodus 10:27 But the Lord hardened Pharaoh's heart, and he would not let them go. **28** Then Pharaoh said to him, "Get away from me; take care never to see my face again, for on the day you see my face you shall die." **29** Moses said, "As you say! I will not see your face again."

The Hand of Moses

Exodus 4:21 And the LORD said to Moses, “When you go back to Egypt, see that you do before Pharaoh all the miracles that I have put in your power. But I will harden his heart, so that he will not let the people go.

The Heart of Pharaoh

Pharaoh thought he had control of his kingdom, but he couldn't even control his own heart.

Exodus 9:15 For by now I could have stretched out my hand and struck you and your people with a plague that would have wiped you off the earth. **16** But I have raised you up for this very purpose, that I might show you my power and that my name might be proclaimed in all the earth.
