Dr. Bruce Waltke, *Genesis* p.22-23



- “Genesis also reports the origins of the nations who are destined to come under Israel’s rule (e.g., ch.10). Furthermore, the historical narrative of Genesis repeatedly and emphatically explains that Israel’s God, the God of creation and the Lord of history, has called Israel to take possession of Canaan and from that basis to bless the nations (e.g., 12:1-3; 15:17).”

The Animal World



Adam, Gen 1:27

- Animals to Adam to be named
- Adam’s transgression, ate the fruit of the tree
- Awareness of nakedness by Adam & covered by God
- Adam’s “eyes were opened” to his sin

Noah, Gen 9:6

- Animals to Noah to be protected
- Noah’s transgression, drank of the fruit of the vine
- Awareness of nakedness by sons & covered by sons
- Noah’s “awoke”

- “The absence of the blessing on the land animals is striking. They are not to have dominion over humanity, who is blessed to rule them. The fish and birds, however, receive blessing since they inhabit different spheres and pose no threat to people.” BK, *Genesis*, p.64

Genesis 1:24-2:7 & The Gospel of John

Gen 1:24-2:7

- God “breathed” into man the “breath” of life, 2:7
- “Thus the heavens & the earth were finished” 2:1, “...God ended His work” 2:2

Gospel of John

- “...He breathed on them, and said to them, ‘Receive the Holy Spirit’ 2:22
- My food is to...finish His work, 4:34, “...it is finished” 19:30
