*Just answer a few questions for me so that we can get to your questions.* 38:1-3
- B. Where were you when I laid out the earth? 38:4-6
- C. (*Where were you when*) I put the stars out and the angels rejoiced? 38:7
- D. Who was it who decided the limits and boundaries of the ocean? 38:8-11
- E. Have you ever directed the morning to burst into dawn across the whole earth? 38:12-15
- F. Have you been into the deepest parts of the oceans (since you know so much)? 38:16
- G. Have you trekked into the place of the dead? 38:17
- H. Have you measured the whole earth? 38:18
