Lesson 7 - The Exodus - Our Salvation March 26, 2019

Israel - Enslaved by Pharaoh - Exodus 1 **Born into slavery Exodus** 12:40

Before salvation - Enslaved by sin and Satan

Born into slavery - Romans 6:17 ... Once you were slaves of sin, but now you wholeheartedly obey this teaching we have given you. (NLT)

Romans 5:12 When Adam sinned, sin entered the world. Adam's sin brought death, so death spread to everyone, for everyone sinned. (NLT)

God planned for and sent Moses to deliver them Exodus 2

God spared him death Exodus 1:22 - Exodus 2:10 Perfectly prepared him Exodus 2:11-4:17 Sent him in at just the right time

God planned for and sent Jesus to deliver us - Genesis 3:15

God spared Him death until it was time - Matthew 2:13-15 After the wise men were gone, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream. "Get up! Flee to Egypt with the child and his mother," the angel said. "Stay there until I tell you to return, because Herod is going to search for the child to kill him." 14 That night Joseph left for Egypt with the child and Mary, his mother, 15 and they stayed there until Herod's death. This fulfilled what the Lord had spoken through the prophet: "I called my Son out of Egypt." (NLT)

Luke 4:28-30 When they heard this, the people in the synagogue were furious. 29 Jumping up, they mobbed him and forced him to the edge of the hill on which the town was built. They intended to push him over the cliff, 30 but he passed right through the crowd and went on his way. (NLT)

Perfectly prepared Him - Baptized by John and Tempted by Satan

Sent Him at just the right time - Galatians 4:4-7 But when the right time came, God sent his Son, born of a woman, subject to the law. 5 God sent him to buy freedom for us who were slaves to the law, so that he could adopt us as his very own children. 6 And because we are his children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, prompting us to call out, "Abba, Father." 7 Now you are no longer a slave but God's own child. And since you are his child, God has made you his heir. (NLT)

God brought plagues upon Egypt to <u>prove His power</u> not only to Egypt but also to Israel Exodus 7-12

God uses Biblical truth and circumstances orchestrated by God to <u>prove</u> <u>Himself to the world</u> - Romans 1:20 For ever since the world was created, people have seen the earth and sky. Through everything God made, they can clearly see his invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature. So they have no excuse for not knowing God. (NLT)

Passover meal - an act of faith - Exodus 12

The perfect lamb
Sacrificed
Blood shed and painted on the entrance of the home

Our salvation - an act of faith Galatians 2:16 Yet we know that a person is made right with God by faith in Jesus Christ, not by obeying the law. And we have believed in Christ Jesus, so that we might be made right with God because of our faith in Christ, not because we have obeyed the law. For no one will ever be made right with God by obeying the law." (NLT)

2 Corinthians 5:21 For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ. (NLT)

Jesus the perfect lamb - *John 1:29 The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! (NLT)*

Sacrificed for us - Hebrews 10:12 But our High Priest offered himself to God as a single sacrifice for sins, good for all time. Then he sat down in the place of honor at God's right hand. (NLT)

Blood shed and spilt on the cross - Colossians 1:20 and through him God reconciled everything to himself. He made peace with everything in heaven and on earth by means of Christ's blood on the cross. (NLT)

Ephesians 1:7 He is so rich in kindness and grace that he purchased our freedom with the blood of his Son and forgave our sins. (NLT)

Crossing the Red Sea - Exodus 14:13-18 (read)

Freed from slavery - Impossible for them to do on their own.

Salvation - Ephesians 2:8-9 God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. 9 Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it. (NLT)

We cannot deliver ourselves or keep ourselves saved.

After crossing - Praise and worship - Exodus 15

At the first trail they doubted God. Mentally they left God at the Red Sea. Needed water - had not seen God provide water for them yet...

After salvation

Real life trials come and we forget the great miracle our salvation is. Do we mentally leave God at the cross?

Do we trust the heart of God or not? We are in Christ. God cares

We trusted Him with the impossible, (salvation) but now we doubt that He will or can meet us in our need.

We still have this life to live before we reach heaven. - This was never meant to be heaven. It's our place to trust God. But is God FOR us or against us?

Romans 8:31 What shall we say about such wonderful things as these? If God is for us, who can ever be against us? 32 Since he did not spare even his own Son but gave him up for us all, won't he also give us everything else? 33 Who dares accuse us whom God has chosen for his own? No one—for God himself has given us right standing with himself. (NLT)

God is our hope in the desert! He makes water that is bitter, sweet. He did not lead them to different water, He changed it so it was sweet.

James 1:2-3 Dear brothers and sisters, when troubles come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy. 3 For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow. (NLT)

God may not take away your trial, but He can make it profitable in your life and therefore it becomes sweet.

Romans 5:3-5 We can rejoice, too, when we run into problems and trials, for we know that they help us develop endurance. 4 And endurance develops strength of character, and character strengthens our confident hope of salvation. 5 And this hope will not lead to disappointment. For we know how dearly God loves us, because he has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with his love. (NLT)

Romans 8:18 Yet what we suffer now is nothing compared to the glory he will reveal to us later. (NLT)

2 Corinthians 4:8-9 We are pressed on every side by troubles, but we are not crushed. We are perplexed, but not driven to despair. 9 We are hunted down, but never abandoned by God. We get knocked down, but we are not destroyed. 10 Through suffering, our bodies continue to share in the death of Jesus so that the life of Jesus may also be seen in our bodies. (NLT)

Proverbs 3:4-6 Then you will find favor with both God and people, and you will earn a good reputation. 5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. 6 Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take. (NLT)

Phil 4:12-13 I know how to live on almost nothing or with everything. I have learned the secret of living in every situation, whether it is with a full stomach or empty, with plenty or little. 13 For I can do everything through Christ,[fn] who gives me strength. (NLT)

Joshua 1:9 This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the LORD your God is with you wherever you go." (NLT)

1 Peter 1:7 These trials will show that your faith is genuine. It is being tested as fire tests and purifies gold—though your faith is far more precious than mere gold. So when your faith remains strong through many trials, it will bring you much praise and glory and honor on the day when Jesus Christ is revealed to the whole world. (NLT)

John 16:33 I have told you all this so that you may have peace in me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world."

God has made us His own by the ultimate sacrifice. He will not abandon us in the desert. We do not ever need to take matters into our own hands and rescue ourselves from trials in the desert, by going against the Word of God!

We are IN CHRIST - What did Jesus do in His trials? Depended on the Father.

We are just like Israel, we forget what the cross has done for us in the past and therefore cannot trust Him for today.

Because we are in Christ, we are like God's chosen people, Israel, redeemed and protected, headed to the Promised Land.

Just like Israel, they had Canaan to look forward to, we have glory to look forward to and it's the reason we can stand firm, be encouraged and keep the faith.

Philippians 3:20 But we are citizens of heaven, where the Lord Jesus Christ lives. And we are eagerly waiting for him to return as our Savior. (NLT)

Because we are in Christ, God is going to care for us and use trials to increase our faith. Even Christ was not without difficulties, it's part of living here on this earth after the fall.
