Books of History

- A. King David ➡ Messiah - David is the last prophesied line of the coming seed of the woman.
- B. 28 generations from David to the Christ (Matthew 1:17)
- C. Kingdom splits after Solomon (1 Kings 12:1-24)
- D. Northern 10 Tribes do not obey God and are exiled (2 Kings 17:1-6)
- E. Southern 2 Tribes also do not obey God and are exiled (2 Chronicles 36:11-24)

No King following David was perfect and none could change the heart of the people. Someone more than a King was needed.

- B. Son of Man

Ezekiel 28:11-15 “You were perfect in your ways from the day you were created, Till iniquity was found in you.”

D. The Old Testament Ends

- a. Nations Rise against Nations – Satan rules contrasted with the initial setting where man was to rule as God’s representatives
- b. Man is not in harmonious relationship with God
- c. Abrahamic Covenant is not evidenced – they do not possess the land, they are not a blessing to the nations
- d. Mosaic Covenant has been broken by Israel time and time again. The nation is now in exile just as God promised
- e. Davidic Covenant looks to be in doubt – no king on the throne
- f. The nation is still waiting for the promised Seed of the Woman
