## CHIASTIC STRUCTURE: 2 SAMUEL 6 (David brings the Ark to Jerusalem)

- (A1) David desires to bring the Ark to Jerusalem: The grand procession begins (6:1-7)
  - a. Outbreak of judgment: God's anger at Uzzah for not respecting the Ark (Uzzah dies) (6:7)
  - (B1) David's reaction: anger and fear of God (6:8-9)
    - (C1) David sends the Ark to Obed-Edom's house (6:10)
      - (D1) The ark stays at Obed-Edom's house three months; God blesses him (6:11)
      - (D2) It is reported to David that God had blessed Obed-Edom because of the Ark (6:12)
    - (C2) David brings the Ark from Obed-Edom's house to Jerusalem (6:13a)
  - (B2) David's reaction: gladness & fear (reverent) (6:13b-14)
- (A2) The grand procession resumes (6:15)
  - a. Outbreak of judgment: Michal's anger at David for not respecting himself as king (6:16)

(Reward) Blessing on the people; barrenness for the bride

## CHIASTIC STRUCTURE: 2 SAMUEL 7 (David receives the Davidic Covenant)

- (A1) David voices his intention to build a Temple (7:1-2)
  - **(B1)** Nathan speaks of his own counsel (7:3)
    - (C1) God countermands David's desire (7:4-11)
    - (C2) God grants David eternal kingship (7:12-16) –
  - (B2) Nathan relays God's determination (7:17)
- (A2) David gives thanks (7:18-29)

- (1a) David will be the dynastic father (7:12)
  - (2a) God will establish the son's kingdom (7:12)
    - (3) The son will build a house for My Name (7:13)
  - (2b) God will establish the throne of his kingdom (7:13)
- (1b) God will be his Father and David's son will be God's son (7:14)
- (**Reward**) The son will be chastened for sin, but God's mercy will not depart from him (7:14-15)
