Christ created light and he himself is the light: John 1:4-5, Matt4:16, Isa 9:2

Three questions to start the day

(Jn 1) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. (2) He was in the beginning with God. John 1:1-2 (NASB)

(Jn 2) He was in the beginning with God. (3) All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being. John 1:2-3 (NASB)

(Jn 4) In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men. (5) The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it. John 1:4-5 (NASB)

(Isa 18) For this is what the LORD says-- he who created the heavens, he is God; he who fashioned and made the earth, he founded it; he did not create it to be empty, but formed it to be inhabited-- he says: "I am the LORD, and there is no other. Isaiah 45:18 (NIV)

(Col 15) He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. (16) For by Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him. (17) He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together. (18) He is also head of the body, the church; and He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that He Himself will come to have first place in everything. (19) For it was the Father's good pleasure for all the fullness to dwell in Him, (20) and through Him to reconcile all things to Himself, having made peace through the blood of His cross; through Him, I say, whether things on earth or things in heaven.

(Ge 1) In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Genesis 1:1 (NIV)

(Ge 2) Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters. Genesis 1:2 (NIV)

(Ge 3) And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. Genesis 1:3 (NIV)

(Jn 3) All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. John 1:3 (KJV)

(Jn 2) He was with God in the beginning. John 1:2 (NIV)

What did Jesus Believe about creation.

(Mt 3) And some Pharisees came to Him, testing Him, and saying, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for any cause at all?" (4) And He answered and said, "Have you not read, that He who created them from the beginning MADE THEM MALE AND FEMALE (5) and said, 'FOR THIS CAUSE A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER, AND SHALL CLEAVE TO HIS WIFE; AND THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH'? (6) "Consequently they are no longer two, but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let no man separate." Matthew 19:3-6 (NASB77)

(Ge 27) And God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. Genesis 1:27 (NASB77)

(Mt 23) And so upon you will come all the righteous blood that has been shed on earth, from the blood of righteous Abel to the blood of Zechariah son of Berekiah, whom you murdered between the temple and the altar. Matthew 23:35 (NIV)

(Lk 17) "Just as it was in the days of Noah, so also will it be in the days of the Son of Man. (27) People were eating, drinking, marrying and being given in marriage up to the day Noah entered the ark. Then the flood came and destroyed them all. (28) "It was the same in the days of Lot. People were eating and drinking, buying and selling, planting and building. (29) But the day Lot left Sodom, fire and sulfur rained down from heaven and destroyed them all. Luke 17:26-29 (NIV)

(Jn 56) Your father Abraham rejoiced at the thought of seeing my day; he saw it and was glad." John 8:56 (NIV)

(Jn 45) "But do not think I will accuse you before the Father. Your accuser is Moses, on whom your hopes are set. (46) If you believed Moses, you would believe me, for he wrote about me. John 5:45-46 (NIV)

(Ge 4) God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness. Genesis 1:4 (NIV)

(Mt 16) the people living in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned." Matthew 4:16 (NIV)

(Jn 12) When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." John 8:12 (NIV)
