

## 1 Peter 3:1-7

---

Verse 2:13: Be subject for the Lord's sake...

Verse 2:18: Servants, be subject to your masters with all respect...

Verse 2:23: When he was reviled, he did not revile in return; when he suffered, he did not threaten, but continued entrusting himself to him who judges justly.

---

Verses 1 and 2 - **Likewise**, wives, be subject to your own husbands...

**so that** even if some do not obey the word, they may be won without a word by the conduct of their wives,

Phil 3:7-8

1 Corinthians 9:19-21

**when** they see your respectful and pure conduct.

Verses 3-4 -Do not let your adorning be external

*Kosmos*

the braiding of hair and the putting on of gold jewelry, or the clothing you wear

1 Timothy 2:9

**but** let your adorning be the hidden person of the heart with the imperishable beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit,

**which** in God's sight is very precious.

Verses 5-6 - For this is how the holy women who hoped in God **used to** adorn themselves, by submitting to their own husbands,

**as** Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord.

**And** you are her children, if you do good and do not fear anything that is frightening.  
"if you do good" 2:15, 2:20, 3:17

Verse 7 - **Likewise**, husbands, live with your wives in an understanding way, showing honor to the woman as the weaker vessel,

Weak vs. Weaker

**since** they are heirs with you of the grace of life,

**so that** your prayers may not be hindered.

Ephesians 5:22-33/Colossians 3:18-25

*Kephale*
