Slide 3- Setting – Background to Understand the Story.

1. Beginning of Time and History
2. God existed prior to Time and History

Slide 4- Setting – Introduces Characters and Casts them in a Certain Light

1. God as Us
2. Man created as image of God, pinnacle of Creation

Slide 5- Setting - Lays out the ideal- how things should be

1. Man in harmonious relation with God the creator, each other, and all of creation
2. Man ruling over God's creation as His representatives
3. Man intending to fulfill the directive to be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth

Slide 7- Initial Conflict- How is the Setting upset by the Antagonist?

1. Man and God's relationship is broken – Death
2. Satan now has dominion over the earth

Slide 8- Initial Conflict – What is the Promise as to how this will be resolved?

1. Seed of the woman will crush the defeat the serpent but will suffer in doing so
2. Marriage relationships will be strained as will childbearing – demonstrating need for a savior
3. Work will be toilsome – demonstrating need for a savior

Slide 10- Rising Action – What are the choices made by the protagonist and antagonist?

1. Protagonist makes covenants with mankind – Antagonist attempts to thwart them
2. Protagonist secures the line of the Seed of the Woman – Antagonist attempts to stop the line of the Seed of the Woman

Slide 11- **Climax**

Slide 12 – Climax – How are the plans of God shown successful and Satan's thwarted?

1. Jesus is born according to all prophecy – Satan did not interrupt the lineage
2. Jesus dies on the cross taking humanity's punishment – God is satisfied – Satan bruises the Seed's heel
3. Jesus rises from the dead receiving all authority in heaven and earth securing salvation

Slide 14 – Resolution – Where is tension still evident after the Climax?

1. Humanity still suffers death yet with offer and hope of resurrection
2. Humanity still suffers broken relationships yet with hope of peace
3. Satan still prince of this world but knows his doom and yet a puppet to God's purposes

Slide 15 – Resolution – How and when are these tensions removed?

1. At His Coming
 - a. Rapture of the Church
 - b. 70th Week of Daniel
 - c. 1000 yrs of Christ's reign
2. At the Final Judgement
 - a. Satan cast into Lake of Fire
 - b. Death cast into Lake of Fire

1. Man and God are once again in harmonious relationship
2. Man is in harmonious relationship with creation and one another

3. Man is ruling over the earth as God's perfected representatives

1. Man in a more intimate relationship with God as the Bride of Christ
2. God Dwells with Man as the Temple in the New Jerusalem which is the Church
3. Tree of Life is present but no more opportunity for sin and disobedience
