Sometimes trials will be used for correcting our thinking or for strengthening or refining our character.

What trials have produced important corrections in your thinking about Jesus, salvation, God's sovereignty, etc?

How has your character benefitted as a result of a particular trial?

What event(s) in your life seriously challenged your faith; caused you to question God's goodness?

Do you allow a mature Christian friend to walk alongside of you during challenging times?

Sometimes trials will be used to expose sin in order to encourage repentance and restoration.

Has there been a time(s) in your life when you sensed or knew you were drifting away from God?

Are there idols (distractions. diversions) in your life right now that are compromising your faith?

How can we discern whether or not God's silence is meant to refine us or restore us?

- ⁸ "Behold, I go forward, but he is not there, and backward, but I do not perceive him;
- ⁹ on the left hand when he is working, I do not behold him; he turns to the right hand, but I do not see him.
- ¹⁰ But he knows the way that I take; when he has tried me, I shall come out as gold.
- ¹¹ My foot has held fast to his steps; I have kept his way and have not turned aside.
- ¹² I have not departed from the commandment of his lips;
 - I have treasured the words of his mouth more than my portion of food.
- ¹³ But he is unchangeable, and who can turn him back? What he desires, that he does.
