- 3:13-14 "What is his name?
- 6:2-8 "Your fathers did not know me by that name"; the "I will" promises
- 9: 12 Why does God harden Pharaoh's heart? (4:21, 10:20, 11:9, etc.)
 - Word study: to know: "yada"
 - O Gen 3:5, 7 know good and evil; 5:2 Pharaoh I do not know the Lord; 6:7 you shall know that I am the Lord; 7:17 say to Pharaoh, by this you will know that I am the Lord; 9:14 I will send my plagues to your very heart, so that you will know; 14:4, 18 so the Egyptians will know that I am the Lord
- 12:12 "And I will bring judgment on all the gods of Egypt"
- What's the relationship between the Passover and the Cross?
- Ch 15 note the foreshadowing; what does this say about God's ultimate purposes?
