God's personal name is revealed: YHWH Yahweh, Jehovah

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth Gen 1:1

The the earth was formless and empty Gen 1:2a

And darkness covered the face of the deep Gen 1:2b

And the spirit of God was hovering on the face of the water. Gen 1:2c
