Summary of Genesis-Joshua

- Israel has been chosen as the people of God through whom God is seeking to establish His desires seen in creation (the ideal).
 - God will accomplish this through an individual from Israel – the seed of the woman
 - God has a desire to use Israel as a nation to move towards establishing the ideal

- God is seen as absolutely faithful to all covenants He has made
 - Faithful to the Abrahamic Covenant
 - Faithful to the Mosaic Covenant
