  - c. Jesus' claims rejected by the many

  - a. Betrayal
  - b. Beatings
  - c. Crucifixion
  - d. Death
4. Jesus' triumph:
  - a. Rises from the dead
  - b. Receives all authority in heaven and earth
  - c. Commissions his followers
  - d. Ascends to clouds

### The Lineage of Jesus the Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham

1. Legal Line through Joseph, Mary's husband – Matthew 1: 1-17 Abraham to Joseph
2. Biological Line through Mary – Luke 3: 23-38 Mary back to Adam
3. What do these lineages speak to the the Narrative that we are following?  
How do these relate to the Setting vs Initial Conflict?

### Jesus' Ministry and Claims

1. John the Baptist – Baptism of Jesus, John's question of Jesus "Are you the One?"

2. Signs and Wonders to prove His claims
3. Son of Man has the authority to forgive sins
4. What do these claims and signs and responses speak to the the Narative that we are following? How do these relate to the Setting vs Initial Conflict? How do these relate to the Covenant God made with Abraham? With the nation of Israel? With Judah? With David?

### Jesus' Sufferings

1. Jesus' betrayal by Judas, His companion
2. Jesus' betrayal by his bretheren
3. Jesus' abandonment by his followers
4. Jesus' death at the hands of the Gentile Romans
5. What do these sufferings speak to the the Narative that we are following? How do these relate to the Setting vs Initial Conflict? How do these relate to the Covenant God made with Abraham? With the nation of Israel? With Judah? With David? What do these sufferings accomplish in settling the Conflict?

### Jesus' Triumph

1. Jesus' resurrection
2. Jesus' appearing to His followers
3. Jesus' receives all authority, commissions His followers, ascends into the clouds
4. How do the Gospels end? Is the conflict over? Is there a clear winner? Is humanity back in right relationship with God? Is the King on the Throne of David? Are the Israelites possessing the land in full and in peace?
