

FBC Discipleship Framework UPDATE

Re: The upcoming **Discipleship Modules** Booklet

I understand that the FBC Discipleship Team, in the near future, will be releasing a booklet called **Discipleship Modules** as part of the Discipleship Framework.

That booklet will present a 'discipleship compendium' of 25 Modules as described below:

". . . This booklet was designed to be used by someone who has never discipled another person but is willing to, with a little guidance. Its intent is to expose the disciple to various aspects of the Christian life and to guide a conversation(s) around each topic that can help to provide further context between the mentor and disciple for that specific truth to be incorporated into the life of the disciple. . . "

(**Personal Note:** Because the compendium's successive modules tend to build upon one another, even the most mature believers can benefit from using it.)

Moreover, the future **Discipleship Module Booklet** Intro describes the layout with 3 parts:

- "Objective" Descriptive Goal for considering Spiritual Truths
- "Conversation guides" Questions as well as Biblical passages & other relevant resources
- "Think about it" Further suggestions: additional passages and issues to discover and discuss
- . . . Each module can be covered in one or two sessions which gives material for 25-50 sessions in total. This probably works best in a weekly meeting context so that the disciple has time to think and consider."

BUT WAIT, THERE IS MORE GOING ON THAN MEETS THE EYE!

At about the same time, some of the C.O.D. Men's Study leadership team were also given access to those very same modules and have recently put together what they call:

the "Basic Discipleship Guide"

in order to facilitate calling people toward one-to-one discipleship.

But there is still more! The "Basic Discipleship Guide" is <u>already</u> being released in booklets, each containing 4+ modules, according to the sequence of the 25 module compendium.
