Other words for intimacy are relationship or familiarity or closeness or friendship.

Do you think of God in this way?

LESSON ONE...Our longing for Intimacy

Our book states..."there is within each of us a longing for love and intimacy that only HE can fulfill."

Do you believe this is true for you?

Our book also asserts..."This is true intimacy: confidence that what we reveal about ourselves will be understood and that the ONE to whom we disclose ourselves will accept us, seek our good, and communicate support and love."

Perhaps the first step toward increased/improved intimacy with GOD is to acknowledge that we actually have a need.

The Psalmist expressed this well:

From Psalm 62.....

Rest Salvation Rock/fortress These words are repeated over and over in this Psalm. Not only is it referring to the character and attributes of GOD, but it is also pointing out what our hearts desire for ourselves.

From Psalm 63......

Thirst

Longing

David expresses his need and then responds to GOD by acknowledging His love and power and glory.

GOD is always responsive to our need of Him.

From Psalm 73.....

Here David is looking around at others and the circumstances he sees. He acknowledges that it bothers him that others prosper.

But he comes to himself in verse 17....."till I entered the sanctuary"

Verse 23.....David testifies of God's faithfulness.

Familiar verses: 23-28.....It is all about the Sovereign GOD who holds us together.

GOD is available to us. We want HIM in our heart of hearts. Can we humble ourselves and acknowledge our need and seek Him?

This question must be answered.

GOD wants to be our light and salvation and stronghold and our confidence.
We are exhorted to "be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord" (vs 14)
Psalm 139This is the best psalm to understand how well God knows each of us.
"knowdiscernperceivehem me inknowledge
You are therefearfully and wonderfully made.
This should be a psalm of great comfort to each of us. When we are known by GOD in this most personal and intimate way, can we not then trust Him?

Our challenge is to move in GOD's direction through time in His Word, through prayer, through being still and letting Him show us His presence through His Spirit in us.

Any relationship takes effort and time and energy. True? How willing are we to invest that time and energy and effort into becoming more intimate with GOD.
