Romans 9:1-11:36 | Key Verse: Romans 10: 9-10

God's Sovereignty in Salvation

In chapters 9-11 Paul addresses the Sovereignty of God in Salvation, both for the Jew and Gentile. He reminds us that we cannot earn Salvation through works, but through faith alone. If we confess and believe, we will be saved. Salvation is for the Jews then the gentiles. Gentiles are grafted into the promises of God for Israel.
