

August 3, 2025 | Pastor Jay Teal Romans 6:1-7:6 | Key Verse: 6:1-23 Freedom From Sin

Grace is not the license to sin. It's an opportunity God is giving us to become who He wants us to be. It's no longer, "I'm gonna live like I want." It becomes, "I'm gonna live like He wants me to!" When you accept Salvation, you also accept Jesus as LORD (boss, master). It's no longer about what you want, but rather, what does the Master say? Sloppy grace is grace we receive to justify sinning. God didn't call us to deal with sin, he called us to be FREE from sin. We don't want to give up since, but we also don't want to be accountable for the cost: death. We want Salvation without lordship, conviction, or sanctification. True salvation will always cause you to submit to the Lordship of Jesus; to be convicted by the Holy Spirit, and be led to live a life of sanctification. Who we are in Christ changes our relationship to sin.
