Sacrificial Living

Paul is appealing to and calling us to present our bodies as living sacrifices. He is talking about not just our "religious" side (or our spirit), but our physicality, mind, emotions, words, hobbies, relationships, and everything else. Offering ourselves to God is not a one and done but a consistent, daily, over and over sacrifice. You can try your entire life to make yourself better, but you will always fall short. Or, in response to his mercy, you can surrender yourself to God and allow him to transform you from the inside out and to train you to become who he wants you to be.

True worship is giving ourselves to God in response to what he has given us.

Real change works from the inside out.

God invites us to join him in transforming our life.
