A Condensed Conversation about Knowing God (John 3:1-15)

Nicodemus: “Your miracles show God has sent you to
teach us.” (3:2)

Jesus: “To see God, you have to be reborn.” (3:3)

Nicodemus: “Physically, that just doesn’t make sense.”
(3:4)

Jesus: “The second time is a spiritual birth.” (3:6-8)

Nicodemus: “How can that happen?” (3:9)

Jesus: “I must be lifted up, so that those who trust me
will have eternal life.” (3:14-15)

A Condensed Message about Knowing God (John 3:16)

"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that
whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life."

As simple as 1, 2, 3 . . .

1. God loves us, so . . .
2. Christ lived and died for us, so . . .
3. Those who trust Christ have eternal life.

Questions to Ponder and Answer

1. If you didn't already know about Christianity, what would you think if someone told you you needed to be born again?"
2. How is it possible to be reborn spiritually? (John 3:5-8, 14-15)
3. What aspects of a person's life demonstrate that he or she has been transformed by the new birth? To what extent does this happen all at once, and to what extent does it take time?
4. Have you been reborn spiritually? If so, how do you know? If not, what can you do about it? What areas of your life still need to be transformed by the Spirit?
5. How is John 3:16 the gospel of Jesus Christ in a concise statement? How can you present the truths of this verse in such a way that your friends will understand them?
