Message Summary:

This was the first message of a new series called Unwrapped. The message started with some fun, a volunteer was asked to come and open an unopenable gift in under 7 seconds. As the volunteer struggled to open the gift, Pastor Kevin stated that our salvation is the same. We cannot be saved by our works, effort, resources, or manpower. Pastor Kevin stated that there are 2 parts to salvation; Gods Part and man's part.

Group Discussion:

- 1. What are some key takeaways from this weekend's message? Why is this so impactful to you?
- 2. <u>Read Luke 1:26-55</u> Mary asked the question "How can this be?" I am already betrothed; I am a virgin. This is a question that I think any of us would ask. Pastor Kevin responds with the reason why Mary would ask such a question and refers us to Mary's Magnificat or Mary's song.
- 3. Pastor Kevin gives us five reasons why Mary was chosen...and how they apply to each one of us as well. First, it is **Because God made me for a purpose** (Read: Luke 1:46-47)
 - A. Do you really believe that God made you for a purpose?
 - B. Most would say that they don't really know what that purpose is. Share with the group on how you can find this purpose in Jesus.

4. Second, it is Because no one cares for me more Read: Luke 1:48a

- A. What is the one sure way we know that God cares for you more than anything else?
- **B.** What is the evidence of this care?
- **C.** What do you think Mary's humble state was? And why do you think her humble state was instrumental in God choosing her to bear the Son of God?

5. Third, Because it is the key to blessing Read: Luke 1:48b-50

A. Why do you think every generation would be affected by this one miracle moment?

B. We read that he will show mercy in every generation and that I will worship him. Knowing this what effect can this have on your home, your family, your friends, and their kids, and their kids after them?

6. Fourth, Because God honors humility Read: Luke 1:51-53

- A. What is humility?
- B. Why does God honor it?

7. Fifth, Because God keeps His promise Read: Luke Luke 1:54-55

- A. The Bible is full of God's promises. If we as Christians believe that God's word is the absolute truth, why do you think it's so difficult for us to believe it and apply it to our lives? Why do you think it's not as easy as "God said it and that settles it"?
- B. Share with the group a time when God has kept His promise in your life?

Weekly Reflection:

- 1. Based on how the Spirit has spoken to you this week, what is one action step you want to take this week to align yourself more fully with Scripture?
- 2. How has your time with God, in the Word and in prayer, been this past week?
- 3. What personal spiritual struggle(s) are you facing right now and how will you actively surrender them to God this week? (Marriage, parenting, work, finances, relationships, personal strongholds/sin, etc.)
- 4. What else can we be praying with you about this week?
