Message Summary:

This was week 2 in our Easter series, “Rise Up” With Tyler Key. This was a message of caution, the difference between a church that could be and a church that is. Tyler gives the example of early church. how the gospel began to spread to all the people. There was such generosity but there was no need for government assistance, they loved one another, they took care of each other’s needs and so much more. All of this can be summed up in one word unity. First, sinners united with God by the preaching of the gospel. United together because we are brought into Gods family. Pastor Tyler paints a picture of what unity in Christ looks like in Gods people.

3. Name a time when you experienced true unity? What caused you to unify? and what was the outcome?

4. Share how being in your small group has benefited and enriched your life in unity?
