This was week 3 of our current series “Redeemed”-We begin to look at the redeemer who was prophesied about in the old testament and many more areas (Micah 5:2,Galatians 4:4-5). Leading into Christmas is the perfect picture of a redeemer who would come by the name of Jesus. Boaz is a picture of Jesus in the old testament as redeemer. We began to look at the requirements that had to be met to be a kinsman redeemer.

Read: Micah 5:2,Galatians 4:4-5

In order to be a kinsman redeemer

- Next of Kin
- Enough Wealth
- Must be willing to Redeem

When it comes to salvation we must understand that there is Gods part to salvation and mans part to salvation. We are going to look at 3 points that describe our part to salvation. We see Naomi start to play match maker with Ruth and wants to help Ruth find a husband.

1. Preparation for the Redeemer- Read Ruth 3:1-3 ; Titus 3:5- Ruth was instructed to prepare herself to present herself to Boaz.

- a. You have been prepared to be in the presence of God. How does this effect how you approach God?
- b. Can you wash yourself?
- c. Why is it important to let God wash you?

2. Presentation to the Redeemer -Read Ruth 3:8-11; John 6:37

The place to live is at the feet of Jesus

- a. what do you think that means to present yourself to Jesus? how should you present yourself to Jesus?
- b. what do you think the place to live is at the feet of Jesus really means?
- c. Are you living at and from the feet of Jesus? why or why not?

3. Proclamation about the Redeemer.- Read Ruth 3:16-18- Pastor Kevin said that we have a salvation because of Jesus, and we who are saved should proclaim or preach the Jesus everywhere we go.

- a. Knowing what Jesus has done for you, is it hard for you to share Jesus?
- b. What are some ways you can proclaim Jesus?
- c. What is stopping you from proclaiming Jesus? how can the group help you to share Jesus?

 - 2. How has your time with God, in the Word, and in prayer been this past week?**
