This week we heard from Pastor Kevin for the final message in the "Devoted" series titled 'The Center of God's Love.' He challenged us to be on the lookout for false teaching from apostates which will increase in the last days. In order to have proper discernment we must remain devoted in several key areas!

What stood out to you the most in this weekend's message? Why was this so impactful to you?

- 1. Read Jude vs. 3-4. In these verses we see that false teachers have been a tactic of the Enemy since the church began.
 - 1. Share a time in your faith journey that you may have encountered false teaching.
 - 2. How the Holy Spirit illuminated this to you?
- 2. Read Jude vs.17-25. These verses encourage the church to keep the faith and to not allow the enemy to surprise, stop, or stifle what God has called His people to do.
 - 1. What are some ways you see Satan attacking the church today in attempt to surprise, stop, or stifle God's people?
 - 2. Are there any areas in your life that you see the enemy trying to make you ineffective for God's kingdom?
- 3. Read Jude vs. 3 & 20. We see in these scriptures that we are to Stay devoted to studying the Bible.
 - 1. What faith action words do you see in these verses?



- 2. How does these admonitions compare to your current discipline of your faith?
- 4. Read Rom. 8:26-27. We are to Devote ourselves to praying in the Holy Spirit.
 - 1. What does it mean to pray in the Holy Spirit?
 - 2. Share an experience in which the Holy Spirit took over during your time of prayer.
- 5. Read Jude v2. & Titus 2:13. We are to Stay devoted to looking for the Lord to return.
 - 1. What are some ways that we should be using our time while we look for the Lord's return?
 - 2. What areas is God laying on your heart to prepare you for His return?
- 6. Read Jude vs. 22-23 & Zech. 3:2. Lastly, we are to Devote ourselves to the witnessing of the lost.
 - 1. When is the last time you shared the gospel of Christ with someone who was lost?
 - 2. Pastor Kevin reminded us that we do not have to travel far to go on the mission field. We live in and worship in a community of approximately 100k residents. How can you begin to share the gospel with the lost around you?
- 7. Spend time as a group praying for one another and building each other up in the faith. Pray for the Lord's return and for the lost in this world especially those around you. Allow the Holy Spirit to move and surrender to His leading.
