- a. Do you believe these deaths are a consequence of their actions to leave Bethlehem? If so, why?
- b. Have you ever felt that your choices have led to God's discipline?

3. Read Ruth 1:14-18

- a. Why did Naomi discourage her daughter-in-laws from coming with her?
- b. Why do you think Ruth was insistent on going with Naomi?
- c. How does Ruth's response to these circumstances differ from Naomi's?



- 4. In Ruth 1:21, Naomi says she went away full and came back empty.
 - a. Why do you think Naomi feels this way?
 - b. Have you ever struggled with bitterness toward God for the choices you made?

5.Reflect on what lessons you learned from Ruth Chapter 1 and share with the group

- 1. Based on how the Spirit has spoken to you this week, what is one action step you want to take this week to align yourself more fully with Scripture?
- 2. How has your time with God, in the Word, and in prayer been this past week?
- 3. What personal spiritual struggle(s), are you facing and how will you actively surrender them to God this week? (Marriage, parenting, work, finances, relationships, personal strongholds/sin, etc.)
- 4. What else can we be praying with you about this week?
