# What is Genuine Forgiveness?

## 1. Remembering how much I've been given.

Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

### 2. Relinquishing my right to get even.

"...Never avenge yourselves. Leave that to God, for He has said that He will repay those who deserve it."

Romans 12:19a TLB

### 3. Responding to evil with good.

"Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you." **Luke 6:27b-28 NIV** 

"(Love) keeps no record of wrongs."

1 Corinthians 13:5b NIV

### 4. Repeating the process as long as necessary.

(Peter asked) "Lord, how often should I forgive someone who sins against me? Seven times?' 'No...' Jesus replied, 'but seventy times seven!"

## Why Offer Grace to Others?

### 1. God is gracious to me.

Make sure that no one falls short of the grace of God and that no root of bitterness springs up, causing trouble and by it, defiling many.
