1. Consider anger's <u>cause</u>.

People with understanding control their anger; a hot temper shows great foolishness.

2. Calculate anger's cost.

A man of wrath stirs up strife, and one given to anger causes much transgression.

Proverbs 29:22 ESV

A person's wisdom yields patience; it is to one's glory to overlook an offense.

Proverbs 19:11 NIV

3. Channel anger's power.

When Jesus saw it, he was indignant and said to them, "Let the children come to me; do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of God.

Mark 10:14 ESV

He looked around at them in anger and, deeply distressed at their stubborn hearts, said to the man, "Stretch out your hand." He stretched it out, and his hand was completely restored.
