## Believing Becomes Seeing When I...

### 1. Obey Jesus in the ordinary.

### 2. Look for Jesus in the moment.

Then Jesus told him, "I entered this world to render judgment—to give sight to the blind and to show those who think they see that they are blind."

**John 9:39 NLT**

### 3. Stand in my faith.

The Jewish leaders still refused to believe the man had been blind and could now see, so they called in his parents. "But what did he do?" they asked. "How did he heal you?" Ever since the world began, no one has been able to open the eyes of someone born blind. If this man were not from God, he couldn't have done it."

### 4. Entrust my life to Jesus.

When Jesus heard what had happened, he found the man and asked, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?" The man answered, "Who is he, sir? I want to believe in him." "You have seen him," Jesus said, "and he is speaking to you!" "Yes, Lord, I believe!" the man said. And he worshiped Jesus.
