


DNA Dino Problem
DNA Detected in Duckbilled Dino!
Dozens of baby dinosaurs were discovered in the 1980s at Two Medicine Formation in northern Montana.

A recent detailed examination of one of the skulls led the team to identify cartilage cells, with **internal structures resembling nuclei and chromosomes (DNA)**.


The duckbilled dino is ‘dated’ @ 75 million years old. Lab-bench studies show that DNA, under the best conditions, lasts a max of about 10,000 years.





Mount St Helens show us how logs, undergoing a volcano catastrophe, could quickly be debarked, form log mats and create layers of peat material at the bottom of Lake/Ocean.

Then buried, this peat layer could form into coal, not over millions of years, but quickly over a short period of time.
