



Joseph - A Type of Christ:

First time when **Joseph** was before the children of Israel, they did not recognize who he really was, that he was promised savior of Joseph's dream, whom they would bow down to.

First time when **Jesus** was before the children of Israel, they did not recognize who He really was, that He was promised savior- the Messiah, whom they should bow down to.

Joseph - A Type of Christ:

When **Joseph's** brothers went back to Canaan: There was a significant time gap between **Joseph's** first appearance with the children of Israel and Joseph's second appearance with the children of Israel.

There was a significant time gap between **Jesus'** first appearance with the children of Israel and Jesus second appearance with the children of Israel that will occur at his second coming.

Joseph - A Type of Christ:

When the children of Israel, appeared before **Joseph** for the second time, they had a repentant heart as Joseph reveals himself to his Jewish brothers and they recognized who he really was, which resulted in their salvation.

Joseph - A Type of Christ:

When the children of Israel, appear before **Jesus** for the second time, when Jesus returns again at the end of the 7 year tribulation period, at His second appearing, the children of Israel will have a repentant heart as Jesus reveals Himself to His Jewish brothers and they recognize who He really is, which will result in their salvation.

God is NOT finished with the nation of Israel yet.

And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: "The Deliverer will come out of Zion, And He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob; For this is My covenant with them, When I take away their sins."

And Joseph situated his father and his brothers, and gave them a possession in the land of Egypt, in the best of the land, in the land of Rameses (Goshen).

Then Joseph provided his father, his brothers, and all his father's household with bread, according to the number in their families.
Now there was no bread in all the land; for the famine was very severe, so that the land of Egypt and the land of Canaan languished because of the famine.

Genesis 47:12-13

So when the money failed in the land of Egypt and in the land of Canaan, all the Egyptians came to Joseph and said, "Give us bread, for why should we die in your presence? For the money has failed." Then Joseph said, "Give your livestock, and I will give you bread for your livestock, if the money is gone."

Genesis 47:15-16

When that year had ended, they came to him the next year and said to him, “We will not hide from my lord that our money is gone; my lord also has our herds of livestock. There is nothing left in the sight of my lord but our bodies and our lands. Why should we die before your eyes, both we and our land? Buy us and our land for bread, and we

and our land will be servants of Pharaoh; give us seed, that we may live and not die, that the land may not be desolate.” Then Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh; for every man of the Egyptians sold his field, because the famine was severe upon them. So the land became Pharaoh’s.

Adopted Sons

For the children of Joseph were two tribes: Manasseh and Ephraim. And they gave no part to the Levites in the land, except cities to dwell in, with their common-lands for their livestock and their property.

Note: Joseph’s Territory Allotment is now 2 Allotments of Territory through Ephraim and Manasseh.
Levi does NOT have any territorial allotment.
