Romans 1:16-17

- 1) The Gospel is the power of God on display for all to see. (vs16)
- 2) The Gospel is the power of God to salvation available for all to experience. (vs16)

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." **John 3:16** 

"For "whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved." Romans 10:13

"For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 9 not of works, lest anyone should boast." **Ephesians 2:8-9** 

"For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly." Romans 5:6

Victory over sin

"...for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." Romans 3:23

"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Romans 6:23

Victory over <u>death</u>

"There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus..." **Romans 8:1**"And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses, <sup>14</sup> having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. **Colossians 2:13-14** 

Victory over <u>Satan</u>

"Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it." **Colossians 2:15** 

3) The power of the Gospel can only be experienced in faith by everyone who believes. (vs16-17)
