## Dear Church Week 4: Thyatira Revelation 2:18-29

1) Christ is characterized by clear judgment. (vs18)

2) Christ commends faithful works. (vs19)

3) Christ condemns for excessive tolerance. (vs20)

"For it is time for judgment to begin at the household of God; and if it begins with us, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God?" 1 Peter 4:17

• Tolerance of the practice of sexual sin in leadership.

"My brethren, let not many of you become teachers, knowing that we shall receive a stricter judgment." **James 3:1** 

'It is actually reported that there is sexual immorality among you, and of a kind that is not tolerated even among pagans, for a man has his father's wife. <sup>2</sup>And you are arrogant! Ought you not rather to mourn? Let him who has done this be removed from among you." **1 Corinthians 5:1-2** 

- The tolerance of bad <u>theology</u>.
- The tolerance of *immorality*.

Matthew 18:15-20

1 Corinthians 5:1-5, 9-13

"Flee sexual immorality. Every sin that a man does is outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality sins against his own body." **1 Corinthians 6:18** 

4) Christ corrects with Godly discipline. (vs21-25)

- God's discipline is fair. (vs21, 24-25)
- God's discipline should be <u>feared</u>. (vs22-23)

5) Christ challenges with future promises. (vs26-29)
