



# Hypocrites and Howlers


Matthew 6:1-6; 16-18



Why do we do what we do?

Beware of practicing your righteousness before other people in order to be seen by them, for then you will have no reward from your Father who is in heaven.





Beware of practicing your righteousness before other people in order to be seen by them, for then you will have no reward from your Father who is in heaven.

#### Live for the approval of God...not the approval of man.

#### Colossians 3:23-24:

"Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ."

You were created by God for the glory of God.

#### Example #1: Giving

Thus, when you give to the needy, sound no trumpet before you, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may be praised by others. Truly, I say to you, they have received their reward. But when you give to the needy, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, so that your giving may be in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you.

### Example #1: Giving

Wrong way: giving to draw attention to the giver

Result: the praise of others

Right way: give in secret

#### Example #2: Praying

And when you pray, you must not be like the hypocrites. For they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and at the street corners, that they may be seen by others. Truly, I say to you, they have received their reward. But when you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you.

### Example #2: Praying

Wrong way: praying to be seen by others

Result: the looks of others

Right way: pray in secret

#### Example #3: Fasting

And when you fast, do not look gloomy like the hypocrites, for they disfigure their faces that their fasting may be seen by others. Truly, I say to you, they have received their reward. But when you fast, anoint your head and wash your face, that your fasting may not be seen by others but by your Father who is in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you.

### Example #3: Fasting

Wrong way: fasting to draw attention to yourself

Result: the attention of others

Right way: fast to be seen by God

Jesus wants genuine followers who strive to be like Him in all of life.

Do you want to be happy?

We were made for God, and so our hearts are like restless pilgrims, going on endless journeys for happiness through God's creation, when all we really need to do is come home to the One who made us.
