If Joseph had never been betrayed by his brothers, **then** he never would've been bought in Egypt by Potiphar.

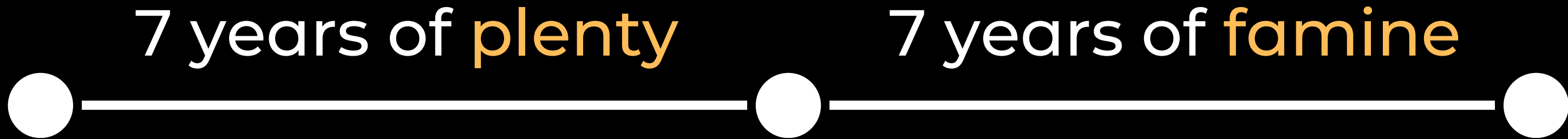
If Joseph had never been bought by Potiphar, **then** he never would've been placed in the prison of the king.

Your **misery** is not meaningless.



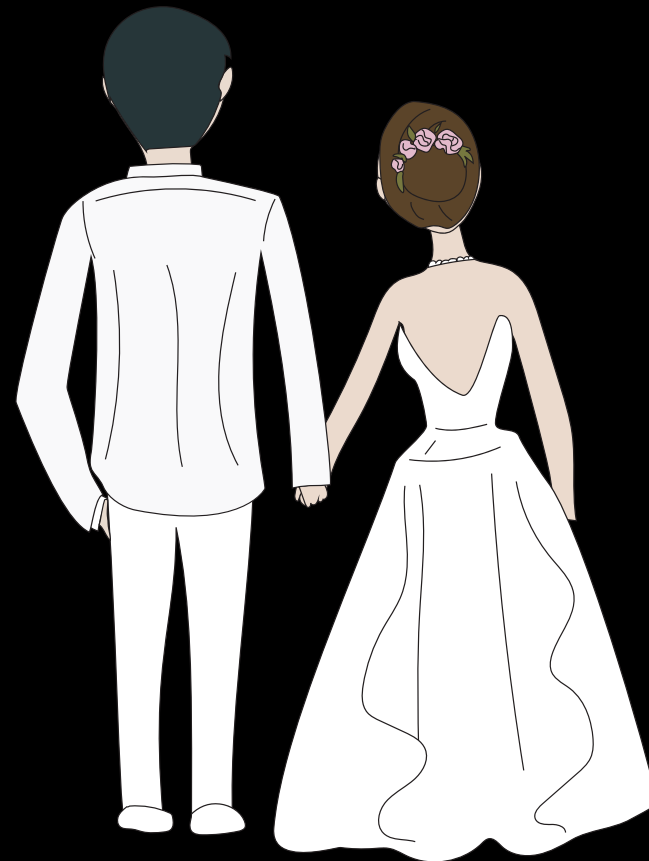






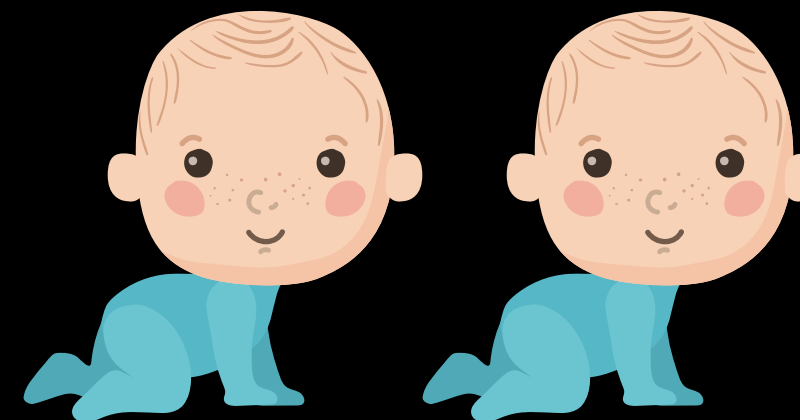
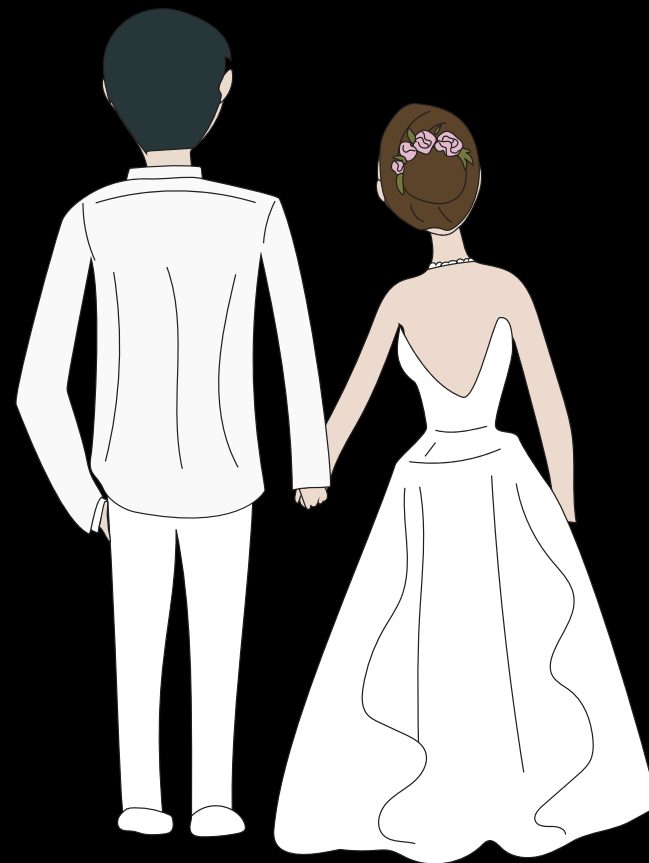
