FOCUS: AFRICA

The Fulani people are one of the largest ethnic groups in central and western Africa. Mostly herdsman, they live in the Sahel region where it is hot and dry and they speak a language called Fulfulde. Some friends of ours who work with the Fulani were meeting with a family one Sunday morning. Recently they were reading in Hebrews 6. The first part of verse 19 says “*We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure.*”. My friend searched the Fulfulde text to see which word was



used for ‘anchor’, since cattle herders in the desert of the Sahel don’t have much context for anchors. Instead, the word that was used was the term for the center post of a grass hut. That center post is what gives the hut its strength. It keeps the hut upright, secure and grounded. What an awesome word picture of what our hope is in times of trouble.
