### Genesis 1:1-2 NIV

<sup>1</sup> In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. <sup>2</sup> Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.

### 1 Kings 18:36-39 NIV

<sup>36</sup> At the time of sacrifice, the prophet Elijah stepped forward and prayed: "Lord, the God of Abraham, Isaac and Israel, let it be known today that you are God in Israel and that I am your servant and have done all these things at your command. <sup>37</sup> Answer me, Lord, answer me, so these people will know that you, Lord, are God, and that you are turning their hearts back again."

<sup>38</sup> Then the fire of the Lord fell and burned up the sacrifice, the wood, the stones and the soil, and also licked up the water in the trench.

<sup>39</sup> When all the people saw this, they fell prostrate and cried, "The Lord—he is God! The Lord—he is God!"

#### Isaiah 61:1-3 NIV

- <sup>1</sup> The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor.
- He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners,
- <sup>2</sup> to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor and the day of vengeance of our God,
- to comfort all who mourn,
- <sup>3</sup> and provide for those who grieve in Zion—
- to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes,
- the oil of joy
  - instead of mourning,
- and a garment of praise
  - instead of a spirit of despair.
- They will be called oaks of righteousness,
  - a planting of the Lord
  - for the display of his splendor.

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

- 1. What about this weekend's message or worship most impacted you?
- 2. What have you believed about the Holy Spirit? Did anything you experience this weekend change your perspective?
- 3. The Spirit is like a wind that brings 3 things: Presence (Genesis 1:1-2), Power (1 Kings 18:36-39), and Proclamation (Isaiah 61:1-3). Take some time with your group to discuss how these 3 things work together, and how you have seen that played out in the Bible and in your life.
- 4. We should only ask for the tools of the Spirit if we are ready to do the work. Are you ready to do the work? If yes, what is 1 thing you can do this week to allow the Spirit to use you? If you are not ready, what it holding you back?
