INVOCATION & (ALL TO WORSHIP

- P: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

- P: On the last and greatest day of the Feast, Jesus stood and proclaimed in a loud voice, 'If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink.'

(ONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: It was on the day of Pentecost that, as Jesus had promised, the Holy Spirit was poured out on His disciples, enabling them to spread God's Word. In his explanation to the Third Article of the Apostles' Creed, Luther wrote, "I believe that I cannot by my own reason or strength believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, or come to Him; but the Holy Spirit has called me by the Gospel, enlightened me with His gifts, sanctified and

kept me in the true faith." Because the Holy Spirit has worked that faith in our hearts, we know that if we confess our sins, God, who is faithful and just, to forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1

John 1:9). Most gracious heavenly Father,

C: we come to You in all humility, confessing that we have sinned against You and against our neighbor. Too often we have thought that we have courageously reached up to You, when in reality You have sent Your Holy Spirit down into our hearts. For the sake of Your Son, forgive our pride and all those things we have thought, said, or done that were contrary to Your will. Enkindle in us the fire of Your love so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name. Amen.

P: Rejoice! Christ's righteousness, His obeying the Law of God, is credited to you as you are declared righteous in His sight. Faith given by God, rejoices in Christ's work on our behalf. "For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God" (Ephesians 2:8). Therefore, as a called and ordained servant of Christ, I joyfully forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son

and of the Holy Spirit.

PROFESSION OF FAITH: THE APOSTLES' (REED

P: What does it mean that you believe in the Holy Spirit?

C: I believe that I cannot by my own reason or strength believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, or come to Him; but the Holy Spirit has called me by the Gospel, enlightened me with His gifts, sanctified and kept me in the true faith. In the same way He calls, gathers, enlightens, and sanctifies the whole Christian Church on earth, and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the one true faith. In this Christian Church He daily and richly forgives all my sins and the sins of all believers. On the last day He will raise up me and all the dead, and give eternal life to me and all believers in Christ. This is most certainly true.
