## **1 Corinthians 11-14:Worship That Builds**

**Sermon:** 1 Corinthians 13

**Date:** Sunday, March 8, 2026

1. *Read 1 Corinthians 13:1-3.* What specific examples does Paul give of things that are worthless without love? Why do you think he chose these particular examples for the Corinthian church?
2. During the sermon Pastor Jared replaced "love" in verses 4-7 with "Jesus." How does this change the way you might view these verses? Which characteristic of Jesus' love stands out most to you and why?
3. Can you think of a time when you served, gave, or used your gifts without love being the primary motivation? What was the result?

4. Which of the five practices for cultivating intimacy with God is most challenging for you? What specific obstacle keeps you from prioritizing this practice?

- Dedicated devotional time in the Bible
- Prayer
- Quiet Time and Reflection
- Having “fun” in God’s Presence
- Caring for our bodies

5. *Reread verses 4-7 and do a personal “love inventory.”* Which characteristic of love (patient, kind, not envious, etc.) do you most struggle to demonstrate? Who in your life needs to experience this aspect of love from you this week?

6. How does understanding that God's love is permanent and eternal rather than conditional or performance-based change the way we approach our relationship with Him?
